Free Community Presentation

This presentation is designed for parents whose children have recently been diagnosed with autism. It covers basic characteristics of Autism Spectrum Disorders, how families integrate their feelings about having a child with a disability, and how to get started on a path to helping your family support your child.

Autism Spectrum Disorders are currently being diagnosed in approximately 1 in every 54 children according to a 2020 study by the Center for Disease Control and Prevention. It has become the fastest growing developmental disability in the United States, so knowing what programs, services and support are available for families is the first step on this journey.
